**SUMMER HOURS** at Hebron begin next Sunday, with Sunday School at 9:00 a.m. and Morning Worship at 11:00, followed by Lemonade on the Lawn.

**LEMONADE ON THE LAWN BEGINS NEXT SUNDAY** – Lemonade on the Lawn, Hebron’s popular summertime fellowship event following Sunday morning worship, will begin on June 2 this year. A sign up-sheet is posted on the bulletin board outside the church office. If no one signs up to provide refreshments, Lemonade on the Lawn will not be held on that Sunday.

**PENTECOST OFFERING** – Hebron will receive the Pentecost Offering beginning on the Day of Pentecost, June 9. This offering is one of four denominational offerings in the Presbyterian Church (USA), of which Hebron is a member; the other three are: One Great Hour of Sharing, the Peace and Global Witness offering (formerly the Peacemaking Offering), and the Christmas Joy Offering (formerly the Joy Gift). Gifts to the Pentecost Offering go to help at-risk youth. Sixty percent goes to the PC (USA) for national and international distribution, while 40% of the offering remains in our community to support local programs. The Commitment/ Witness Committee has designated the recipient of the local portion of the offering to be the Shenandoah Office on Youth, which helps at-risk youth and young adults throughout our area.

#### **LOOKING AHEAD ~**

**Monday, May 27**, is Memorial Day; the Church Office will be closed.

**Thursday, May 30**, is the Day of Ascension of the Lord. Scripture tells us that Jesus appeared to his disciples for a period of 40 days after Easter, proving that he was alive after the Resurrection and giving final instructions to his followers. The Ascension is recorded at Luke 24:45-53, and Acts 1:1-11.

**Sunday, June 9**, is the Day of Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit fell upon the gathered believers in Jerusalem. The story is told in Acts 2:1-21; Peter’s sermon on the Day of Pentecost is recorded at Acts 2:14-41.

**Sunday, June 16**, is Trinity Sunday, and we will celebrate the Lord’s Supper during morning worship.
