DR. ROB MARSH TO SPEAK – As part of Staunton's *Happy Birthday America* celebration during 4th of July week, well-known and respected physician Dr. John 'Rob' Marsh will speak Tuesday night, July 3, as part of the Vesper Service which begins at 6:30 p.m. in Gypsy Hill Park. Dr. Marsh was named the 2014 *Country Doctor of the Year* for the United States. He served as a military physician in the US Army and he is remembered for directing the medical care of Army Rangers and Delta Force soldiers in the October 1993 events that have been chronicled as *Blackhawk Down*. Dr. Marsh is one the most decorated military physicians in the U.S., having earned the Legion of Merit, two Bronze Stars, a Purple Heart, the Department of Defense Meritorious Service Medal, and the Army Meritorious Service Medal.
