HURRICANE FLORENCE RELIEF – When the bulletin was printed Friday morning, Hurricane Florence was still in the vicinity of Wilmington, NC, and its path was unknown. The forecast was for the hurricane to cross South Carolina and the Appalachian Mountains and then move up through North Carolina, Tennessee, Kentucky, West Virginia, Ohio and Pennsylvania, and then move northeast through Pennsylvania, New York and New England, but nothing is certain until it happens. Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) will receive donations to help victims of the storm, and you are encouraged to be generous in supporting relief efforts, but it may be best to wait until the storm is over to know where help is most needed; even though the storm was expected to move west of the Shenandoah Valley, that is by no means guaranteed. You can give to PDA by noting your check or gift, or by telling the Treasurer, Mike Ruleman, that you want your contribution to go to Hurricane Florence relief.
