LENTEN DISCIPLINES – The three most common practices of Lent, referred to as the "Lenten disciplines," are prayer (increased spirituality and a deeper devotional life), fasting (self-denial) and alms-giving (increased charitable giving, and engaging in good works). Lent is the 40 days before Easter, not counting Sundays, which, as the Christian Sabbath, should already be devoted to worship, prayer, and drawing closer to God.
