SIECK EARNS Ph.D. – Jennifer Sieck offers warm thanks for your support during her graduate study at George Washington University. Encouragement taking many forms (cards, calls and kind words, among others) helped her make this long journey. She defended her dissertation in March and received her Ph.D. in May. Her research explored music, dance and quilting in African American literature. One of her four chapters was on Julia Foote, a nineteenth-century African American preacher who wrote and included a hymn called "Holy Is the Lamb" in her spiritual autobiography. Foote improvised on an existing hymn whose first line is "Mixture(s) of joy and sorrow," adding the chorus after which she titled her hymn. Along with her dissertation, whose acknowledgments express gratitude for Hebron's congregation, Jennifer uploaded a recording of Foote's hymn made by a friend of her brother, John Philip. She continues to work at GW while searching for a job in her field.

Signature Quilt in the Gold Room – In the course of her research, Jennifer learned that a national pilot project to document signature quilts – like the one in the Gold Room – began in summer 2009.
