PRAYER FOR ILLUMINATION

FIRST OLD TESTAMENT LESSON ~ Genesis 22: 1-2, 9-13 ~ Pages 16-17 in pew Bible

After these things God tested Abraham, and said to him, “Abraham!” And [Abraham]  
said, “Here I am.” [God] said, “Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go  
to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering upon one of the mountains of  
which I shall tell you.”

When they came to the place of which God had told him, Abraham built an altar there,  
and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar, upon the  
wood. Then Abraham put forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son. But the angel of  
the LORD called to him from heaven, and said, “Abraham, Abraham!” And he said, “Here I  
am.” He said, “Do not lay your hand on the lad or do anything to him; for now I know that  
you fear God, seeing you have not withheld your son, your only son, from me.” And Abra-  
ham lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him was a ram, caught in a thicket by  
his horns; and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up as a burnt offering instead  
of his son.

SECOND OLD TESTAMENT LESSON ~ Numbers 21: 4-9 ~ Page 134 in the pew Bible

From Mount Hor they [the Israelites] set out by the way to the Red Sea, to go around the  
land of Edom; and the people became impatient on the way. And the people spoke against  
God and against Moses, “Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness?  
For there is no food and no water, and we loathe this worthless food” [the manna that God  
provided]. Then the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people, so  
that many people of Israel died. And the people came to Moses, and said, “We have sinned,  
for we have spoken against the LORD and against you; pray to the LORD, that he take away  
the serpents from us.” So Moses prayed for the people. And the LORD said to Moses, “Make  
a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole; and every one who is bitten, when he sees it, shall live.”  
So Moses made a bronze serpent, and set it on a pole; and if a serpent bit any one, they  
would look at the bronze serpent and live.

GOSPEL LESSON ~ John 3: 13-21 ~ pg. 924 in pew Bible

[Jesus said] “No one has ascended into heaven but he who descended from heaven, the

Son of man. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.” For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God sent the Son into the world, not to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. He who believes in him is not condemned; he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. And this is the judgment, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one who does evil hates the light, and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. But he who does what is true comes to the light, that it may be clearly seen that his deeds have been wrought in God.
