OLD TESTAMENT LESSON ~ Deuteronomy 8: 1-20 ~ Pages 159-160 in the pew Bible

[Moses said,] "All the commandments which I command you this day you shall be careful to do, that you may live and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD swore to give to your ancestors. And you shall remember all of the way how the LORD your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, that God might humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep God's commandments, or not. And God humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your ancestors know; that God might make you know that people do not live by bread alone, but that people live by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD. Your clothing did not wear out upon you, and your foot did not swell, these forty years. Know then in your heart that, as a parent disciplines their child, so the LORD your God disciplines you. So you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God, by walking in God's ways and by holding in proper awe and reverence. For the LORD your God is bringing you into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and springs, flowing forth in valleys and hills, a land of wheat and barley, of vines and fig trees and pomegranates, a land of olive trees and honey, a land in which you will eat bread without scarcity, in which you will lack nothing, a land whose stones are iron, and out of whose hills you can dig copper. And you shall eat and be full, and you shall bless the LORD your God for the good land he has given you. Take heed lest you forget the LORD your God, by not keeping his commandments and his ordinances and his statutes, which I command you this day: lest, when you have eaten and are full, and have built goodly houses and live in them, and when your herds and flocks multiply, and your silver and gold is multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied, then your heart be lifted up, and you forget the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage, who led you through the great and terrible wilderness, with its fiery serpents and scorpions and thirsty ground where there was no water, who brought you water out of the flinty rock, who fed you in the wilderness with manna which your fathers did not know, that he might humble you and test you, to do you good in the end. Beware lest you say in your heart, 'My effort and the power of my hand have gotten me this wealth.' You shall remember the LORD your God, for it is God who gives you power to get
