CHRISTMAS EVE SERVICES – Hebron Presbyterian Church will hold two Christmas Eve services on Friday, Dec. 24, with a Service of Lessons & Carols at 4:00 P.M., and a Candlelight Christmas Eve Communion Service at 10:00 P.M. The 4 o'clock service of Service of Lessons & Carols will include familiar Scripture lessons from the story of Christmas, and singing entire hymns and/or selected verses from favorite Christmas hymns.
