ANNUAL MEETING TODAY – The Annual Meeting of the Congregation of Hebron Presbyterian Church will be held today, immediately following morning worship. Three items of business are on the agenda:

1. Distribution of the Annual Report (the Session is required to give the congregation an annual report of church activities);
2. Informing the congregation of the 2015 budget (the budget is adopted by the Session, but the Session is required to inform the congregation of the budget); and,
3. Acting on the Terms of Call of the Pastor, with the Session recommending a 2% increase in the pastor’s salary (the church is required to review the pastor’s compensation annually, but only the congregation can change the pastor’s terms of call).

Copies of the 2015 budget adopted by the Session are available in the Vestibules and in the Session Room (along with giving statements for 2014). Please review the budget, and if you have any questions you can ask church treasurer Michael Ruleman or any member of the Session.
