An accomplished organist, Ralph holds Master and Bachelor of Music degrees from George Peabody College for Teachers and a Master of Music Education from Fayetteville State University. He attended summer programs at the Royal School of Church Music in Croydon, England, and the Internationaal Stichting Orgelconconcours, Haarlem, the Netherlands. Ralph is a member of the American Guild of Organists, Chorister’s Guild, Royal School of Church Music, Hymn Society of America, Presbyterian Association of Musicians, American Guild of English Handbell Ringers, Rotary Club, and the Fellowship of United Methodist Musicians. In 1989 he was named to the International Who’s Who in Music. He is also an adjunct faculty member of the Music Department of Piedmont Virginia Community College. Before moving to Charlottesville, Ralph served variously as minister of music, organist and choir director to a number of congregations. In Fayetteville, he was also a full-time elementary school music resource teacher. Ralph and his wife Sonia, a soprano soloist, have three daughters, all of whom are also musicians.
