**THANKS** to all who contributed to the Christmas Joy Offering and to the Christmas Card Offering. The total from congregation for the Christmas Joy Offering was \$334, and the Commitment/Witness Committee added \$166 for a total church gift of \$500. This offering supports needing retired church workers (ministers, missionaries, etc.) and surviving spouses, as well as PCUSA-supported racial/ethnic colleges and universities.

The Christmas Card donations totaled \$311 and the Commitment/ Witness Committee added \$89 for total of \$400. The money was given to support Weekday Religious Education (WRE), with \$300 going to Beverly Manor, \$50 to Churchville, and \$50 to Riverheads.
