Four items are on the agenda, two of which are informational, and two of which require congregational action. Information items are distribution of the Annual Report, detailing activities of the Session, Session Committees, and church organizations; and presenting the 2011 church Budget with a time for questions. The two action items are electing three members of the congregation to serve on the Church Nominating Committee for 2011; and acting on proposed changes to the Pastor’s Call (a 2% increase in salary is proposed).
