VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED to deliver Hebron's contributions to SACRA (the Staunton-Augusta Church Relief Association). You can sign up to collect and deliver donations for a single week, or for an entire month. A sign-up sheet is posted on the bulletin board between the church office and the pastor's office.

FLOODING RELIEF – The Presbyterian Disaster Assistance program (PDA) is actively providing assistance of all kinds to those areas and people affected by recent and ongoing flooding. Numerous states have been impacted by flooding this year due to the melting from heavy snowfall and a higher than average amount of rainfall. More than 150 locations in the central and southern plains states are currently reporting river flooding, the majority of which are in Texas, Oklahoma, Louisiana, Arkansas, eastern Kansas and western Missouri. The relentless rain and storms have affected a wide swath of Texas since the Memorial Day weekend. The severe weather has left at least 23 dead, and an estimated 4,000 homes damaged, washed away, or otherwise destroyed. The best way to help is to give money to relief agencies or charities that you know will send assistance according to needs. You can give to PDA by informing the church treasurer and designating that your contribution go to support flooding, or you can write a separate check noted "DR000191-U.S. Flooding." Write your check or give your contribution to Hebron, and we will forward the total offering to PDA.
