THE PENTECOST OFFERING will be received on Sunday, May 23. This annual offering is one of four national offerings Hebron receives each year, along with the One Great Hour of Sharing Offering at Easter, the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) Peacemaking Offering on World Communion Sunday, and the PCUSA's Christmas Joy offering in December. The Pentecost Offering goes to support children at risk, youth, and young adults locally; and the Young Adult Volunteer Program of the Presbyterian Church (USA), of which Hebron is a member. In receiving the Pentecost Offering, 60% of the amount received goes to the PCUSA denomination for national and international programs, while 40% is retained by the individual church for local mission projects to help young people. The 40% distributed locally will be given to the Boys & Girls Club.
