**More Hunger Information**

**Presbyterian Hunger Program** administers a vast network of programs that focus on alleviating hunger and its root causes. The major changes within the Presbyterian Church (USA) in the last year have not changed this focus for the PHP. Undesignated financial support allows them to continue their work to make the world a more just and a better place for all. The PHP holds steadfast in their ministry to alleviate hunger and its causes both through grants they give and through their programs. In addition to direct food relief, the "Enough for Everyone" program continues to grow with the introduction of the *Eco-Palms Project*. They have also initiated "The Campaign for Fair Food" to look at the social justice issues affecting the food we eat.

**Volunteer Farm + Blue Ridge Area Bank + Congregations** equals an amazing *partnership* to help the hungry in the western Virginia region. The Volunteer Farm is a non-profit charitable program that works through the Blue Ridge Area Food Bank to assist congregations in feeding the thousands of hungry people in 25 counties and 9 cities in the northern mountains of Virginia. Through this partnership, some 16,500 people are sustained each week with fresh, healthy food grown in their own community. Many youth groups, congregations and non-church community organizations support these efforts with the labors of their hands and their hearts of compassion.
