BAJA MISSION LEADER TO VISIT AREA – Asher Motola, leader of Shenandoah Presbytery’s mission trips to Baja, Mexico, will be in our area Sept. 24-27 to talk about this ministry in which many people in the presbytery have participated, as well as to speak about his own faith journey. For the past 14 years, members and friends from Shenandoah Presbytery churches have traveled to Baja, Mexico, on mission trips to build houses and other structures for the Oaxacan native people who live in the Vicente Guerrero area. Originally, folks from Augusta Stone began going to Baja, and then invited other churches to join them. Over the last 16 years, about 770 people from within this presbytery have given a week of their summer to go work alongside residents of Baja to build solid, basic houses. Motola plans and coordinates on-site arrangements, and provides cultural education and insight throughout the trips. He is a Mexico Outreach Leader for *Youth with a Mission*, which is based in Chico, California. He will be in our area Sept. 24-27. His presentations in the presbytery will be:

- Mt. Horeb Presbyterian Church in Grottoes on Thursday, Sept 24, 7:00 p.m. reception and presentation;
- Warrenton Presbyterian Church in Warrenton on Friday, Sept 25, 6:00 p.m. dinner and presentation; and,
- Massanutten Presbyterian Church in Penn Laird on Saturday, Sept 26, 6:00 p.m. dinner and presentation.
