

## September: Special Events, and Resume Regular Worship Hours

The annual church Program Year begins Sept. 1, after taking a break for the summer months of June, July and August.

The first event of the new year will be the Presbyterian Women's *Celebration of Life* program, their annual memorial service for those who died in the previous year. The service will be held at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 2. (See story on back page.)

Regular worship hours of 9:55 a.m. for Sunday School for all ages and 11:00 a.m. for morning worship resume on Sunday, Sept. 7.

This year, the Christian Education Committee will host a Back-to-Sunday School Brunch after morning worship. The church will provide a variety of breakfast and brunch foods and beverages. In the past, the committee hosted a kickoff breakfast, but decided to have a brunch/lunch after worship because we have had better attendance and participation with meals after worship than with breakfasts.

Many regular activities of the church will also resume in September, including:

- Circles 1 & 2 meet on second Tuesdays at 1:30 p.m. starting Sept. 9, beginning the new Horizons Bible Study, *Reconciling Paul*, a study of 2 Corinthians;
- Choir practices at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday nights;
- Regular church committee meetings, after many did not meet regularly during the summer.

Two items that the Session will act on in coming months are the result of generous bequests by the late Dr. John B. Riley, a child of Hebron, son of the late J.W. and Edith Riley. At the time of his death last Sept. 16, he was a professor of agricultural economics at the University of Tennessee in Knoxville, TN. He had previously served as Dean of the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources at the university.

John left 5% of his residuary estate to Hebron Presbyterian Church, and he left 6% of his residuary estate to the Scott Hickey Memorial Scholarship Fund at Hebron. This resulted in an unrestricted gift of \$157,830.75 to the general fund of the church, and \$189,396.90 to be added to the endowment fund for the Scott Hickey Memorial Scholarship. The Christian Education Committee will make recommendations on how to reconcile conflicting goals for the scholarship fund. The will says the money will go to "the Scott Hickey Scholarship Fund" and is intended for members of Hebron "who will be a rising college junior and/or senior at a four-year college, or a rising second-year student at a community college or technical institute," while current policy for the scholarship says it goes to a first-year college student.

In any case, the bequest goes into the Scott Hickey scholarship endowment, and only annual interest can be used for scholarships, never any of the principal.

The meeting was adjourned with prayer by the moderator at 8:18 p.m.

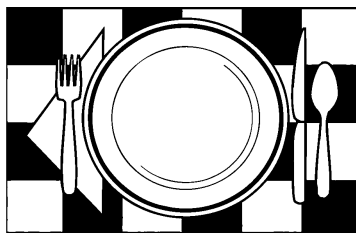

Hebron’s “Celebration of Life” service, sponsored by Hebron’s Presbyterian Women and formerly known as the annual Memorial Service, will be held Tuesday, Sept. 2, at 7:30 p.m. in the church Sanctuary, said event coordinator Meredith Arneson.
