**OGHS** ~Thanks to our generous congregation, **\$421.08** was collected for One Great Hour of Sharing! Great job compared to last year's \$164.43.

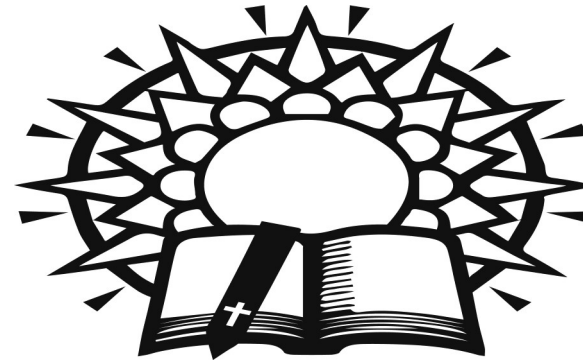
**CLEANUP DAY** ~ Thanks to all who helped on our cleanup day. Some eager beavers even cleaned up sticks and leaves ahead of time!
