LOOKING AHEAD: Upcoming special days on the Christian Calendar include the Day of Ascension, the Pentecost, and Trinity Sunday; Hebron's VBS will be June 15-19.

The Day of Ascension is 40 days after Easter, which means it is always on a Thursday. Because the Day of Ascension is a Thursday, **Ascension Sunday** can be observed either on the Sunday before the Day of Ascension, or the Sunday after. We will observe Ascension Sunday on June 1. The ascension of Jesus is found in Luke 24:50-53, and in Acts 1:6-11.

The Day of Pentecost is 50 days after Easter. This year the date of Pentecost is June 8. The word "pentecost" means "the 50th day" because it comes 50 days after Easter. God commanded the people of Israel to observe three religious festivals every year, including Passover. The term "Pentecost" was used to designate the Festival of Weeks, or the spring harvest festival, which came 50 days after Passover. The account of Pentecost is found in Acts, chapter 2.

Trinity Sunday is the Sunday after Pentecost, which is June 15 this year. We will celebrate the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper during morning worship.

Vacation Bible School will be held at Hebron Sunday, June 15, through Thursday, June 19. Look for more information in upcoming bulletins.
