COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS WERE AWARDED last Sunday by the Christian Education Committee on behalf of the Session. Committee chair Nicola Cahill presented the **Hebron Youth Scholarship** of \$1,000 each to Conor Cahill and Lynne Moore, and the **Scott Hickey Memorial Scholarship** of \$1,717 each to Lisa Ratliff, Tara Ratliff and Andrew Wyche. Both scholarships require recipients to be active members of Hebron Presbyterian Church who have participated in church, Christian education, and youth group activities, and they must complete applications including information about the importance of their faith. The Hebron Youth Scholarship is funded entirely by contributions. The Scott Hickey Memorial Scholarship was begun by family and friends of Scott and received a major donation last year from the estate of the late Dr. John B. Riley, Scott’s uncle; scholarships are awarded from the interest only, with the principal intended to endow ongoing scholarships.
