April 23, 2020

The Moderator, Rev. Kelly-Ann Rayle opened the meeting with prayer and a devotion at 7:00 p.m. A quorum was declared present.

Clerk's Report: Session approved the agenda and the March 26, 2020 Stated Session minutes.

Treasurer's Report: Acting Treasurer Hannah Bush presented a balance sheet as of April 22, 2020 showing assets and liabilities of \$73,847.34. Also presented was a Profit and Loss statement for the period Jan 1, 2020 through Apr 22, 2020 showing net income over expenses of \$19,504.30 for the period.

Old Business: The Moderator asked for a digital copy of the Hebron Operations Manual. Hannah Bush will get that to her.

Committee Reports:

- * Interim Search Committee-(Theresa Moore)—Our MIF was approved by Shen. Presbytery with minor changes to the salary package. Effective Salary is stated as Min=\$45,000, Max=\$50,000. We should be receiving a list of matched candidates soon
- * CAT Committee (Anita Tuttle) – The committee met on 4/19/2020 with our consultant. The next meeting is scheduled for 4/26/2020 to finalize the questions on the CAT.
- * Cemetery-(Tom Cook, Gail Mayer)- no report
- * Christian Ed.-(Lorrie Dean) – Scholarship applications have been received and are being reviewed.
- * Commitment/Witness-(Mike Fallin) -- One Great Hour of Sharing ends on 04/26/2020.
- * Congregational Ministries-(Anita Tuttle) -- Congregational call lists are being used by elders to check in with our Members each month. We also are continuing the 'Elder of the Month' plan. Mike Fallin is 'Elder of the Month' for May.
- * Fellowship/Service-(Anita Tuttle)- no report
- * Personnel-(Theresa Moore)- no report
- * Property—(Charles Buchanan)- Locks on the church doors have been changed and new keys obtained. Brush clean up around the scout hut was completed.
- * Stewardship/Finance-(Hannah Bush) – no report
- * Worship (Theresa Moore) -- 45 to 50 people attended our Easter drive-in service. After discussion of worship plans going forward, session approved a plan to continue the drive-in services on a continuing weekly basis as long as all Covid-19 mitigation practices are followed and the VA Dept of Health will allow such events. Drive-by offering will be collected as currently being done.

Moderator's Report: Rev. Kelly-Ann Rayle stated that she is pleased with our efforts during this transition period. She also warned about 'hacking' e-mails showing up with her name and Bethel on them. These are NOT from her.

New Business: Doug Trimble gave an update on what can be found on our web site.
