Hebron Presbyterian Church – Stated Session Meeting, February 27, 2020

Rev Rayle led group in completing an “Exit Interview” of Pastor Frank which is required by the Committee on Pastoral Transition of Shenandoah Presbytery.

At 7:49 pm, meeting called to order, opened with prayer, welcome, and recognition of guests. Mike Fallin appointed Recording Secretary and quorum declared. Devotional: Call to Worship, Unison Prayer, Scripture Reading from Jeremiah 21:10-14. An Affirmation of Call as an Elder of the Church was read by all.

Larry Mayer was elected clerk by written ballot. Election of treasurer postponed Acting Treasurer Hannah Bush has completed the budget setup in QuickBooks.

Clerk’s Report: The agenda approved on motion from Tom Cook. Minutes of Jan. Stated Session Meeting were corrected and approved. Minutes of called meeting on Feb. 16 were approved. The date for Hebron’s Annual Congregational Meeting was set for March 15, 2020, after worship, to be announced Mar. 1, 8, and 15. A date for Baptism 5 year old of Chloe Bazzreah was set for June 14, 2020. Robin and Mike Ruleman Mike asked to be placed on inactive roll. Margaret Henderson’s transfer to St. Paul’s UMC was approved and clerk was asked to note the both changes in Hebron records.

Treasurer’s Report: As of Feb 27, 2020 Total Assets in Atlantic Union were \$63,366.55. For period Jan 1 to Feb 27, income was \$16,689.06, Expenses were \$11,457.37.

Presbytery Report: Anita Tuttle attended the quarterly meeting Feb. 22, 2020 at First PC, Waynesboro. Minutes available on website for ShenPres. The Presbytery voted to concur with the Overture from Monmouth Presbytery concerning fossil fuels.

Old Business: On motion by Tom Cook, Session approved CAT (*Congregational Assessment Tool*) Team members: Ellen Desper, Donna Kirtley, and David Moore from the Congregation and Anita Tuttle and Robert Christian from Session. .

Cemetery Committee – Larry Mayer reported “All quiet in the cemetery.”

Christian Ed- Lorrie Dean reported that many programs have died from lack of children. The adult education class chooses its course of study; committee was asked to reprogram offerings for current and future.

Commitment/Witness – Martie and Philip Sieck reported that Helen Breeden has running water after Mike Ruleman lined up a plumber to fix the devices pumping water.

Congregational Ministries - Anita Tuttle reported that a need of one of our congregants arose. Stewardship Com worked out a procedure (in the absence of a pastor) that the chairs of Cong. Care and Stewardship could sign off on such requests.

Fellowship/Service - Anita Tuttle and Theresa Moore reported the Feb 15 Sweetheart Spaghetti Dinner was created by David and Theresa Moore. Joan Wright and Gail Mayer were significant contributors. Good attendance. Next event to be Lucky Game Night on Mar 14. The announcement to be in the Mar newsletter.

Personnel – search for Admin Assist postponed until interim pastor could help with choice.

NOTE: All committees should submit revised membership and meeting times to Theresa Moore, Personnel Committee Chair so that the Policy & Procedures Manual can be updated.

Property - Charles Buchanan – security camera/sign to be installed in back parking lot to dissuade people from using the lot. A motion by Hannah Bush on behalf of Property and Stewardship Committees, via email to improve the sound system in the sanctuary was approved by a 8:4. The cost of \$3000 will be covered by funds from New Century Fund-\$1,012, Music Fund-\$1,050, and Sanctuary Fund \$932.

Stewardship/Finance - Hannah Bush presented the committee’s motion that Lock Box for church be closed. If there is need for a lockbox, the Cemetery Committee’s lockbox could be used. Session approved. Need someone to chair the Generosity Team campaign.

Worship – Theresa Moore stated that Supply Ministers have been secured through June 28. The committee recommends no Good Friday Service this year; however, the sanctuary will be open on Good Friday for private prayer and reflection. The bulletin will list other churches in the area offering Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services. There will be an Easter breakfast coordinated with Fellowship and Service. A sign-up sheet for breakfast foods will be posted for donations.

Moderator’s Report: An Interim Search Committee (ISC) was formed: Sandy Showalter, Gail Mayer, Theresa Moore, Hannah Bush, David Obenschain. On motion by Tuttle, the committee was approved. They are charged with creating a Minister Information Form (MIF) to submit for approval by the Session and review/approval by the CPT. Once approved, by both parties the MIF will be be uploaded to the Church Leadership Connection website (CLC) for prospective applicants.

New Business: Session voted to accept Robin Ruleman’s resignation as Ruling Elder. On motion of Robert Christian, the session agreed to move forward with 11 Ruling Elders. Liz Pack would like to borrow all of our padded chairs (98) and as many metal chairs as needed for Saturday, May 16 wedding at the Stonewall Gun Club in Buffalo Gap, all to be returned promptly.

Next stated meeting will be Thursday, March 26, 2020 at 7 pm in Fellowship Hall. Closing prayer and adjournment at 9:50 pm.
