1st OLD TESTAMENT LESSON ~ 1 Corinthians 8: 1-13 ~ Page 996 in the pew Bible

Now concerning food offered to idols: we know that "all of us possess knowledge." "Knowledge" puffs up, but love builds up. If any imagine that they know something, they do not yet know as they ought to know. But if one loves God, one is known by God. Therefore, as to the eating of food offered to idols, we know that "an idol has no real existence," and that "there is no God but one." For although there may be so-called gods in heaven or on earth.

1st OLD TESTAMENT LESSON ~ Deuteronomy 6: 1-9 ~ Page 157 in the pew Bible

[Moses said] "Now this is the commandment, the statutes and the ordinances which the LORD your God commanded me to teach you, that you may do them in the land to which you are going over, to possess it; that you may fear the LORD your God, you and your children, and your children's children, by keeping all God's statutes and all God's commandments, which I command you, all the days of your life; and that your days may be prolonged. Hear therefore, O Israel, and be careful to do them; that it may go well with you, and that you may multiply greatly, as the LORD, the God of your ancestors, has promised you, in a land flowing with milk and honey. Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD; and you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. And these words which I command you this day shall be upon your heart; and you shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. 
