THANKSGIVING WORSHIP – The annual Community Thanksgiving Service will be held this year at Smokey Row Baptist Church on Wednesday, Nov. 25, at 7:00 p.m. This annual service is a joint project of Hebron Presbyterian Church, the Arbor Hill Church of the Brethren, the Middlebrook Church of God, New Life Foursquare Gospel Church, and Smokey Row Baptist Church.
